MINUTES of the MEETING of PAINSCASTLE COMMUNITY COUNCIL 6th July 2015

Apologies were received from Powys C Cllr Mr C Davies.

As there were no other objections to the minutes of the meeting held on 18th May 2015 these were signed by the Chairman.

PLANNING: a. Rhosgoch Primary School P/2015/0521, application to demolish existing school and erect 18 dwellings (5 of which are affordable) and a community shop, along with new pedestrian and vehicular access and installation of a package treatment plant. This had been fully discussed with local residents at an open meeting on the 29th June where they put forward their points of view regarding this application. These points and those of the Community Council would be put together in a letter to Powys Planning showing the opposition to the application.

FINANCE: a. Accounts (i) Current a/c £2,731.76

b. Audit, this has been completed and sent to the external auditor.

HIGHWAYS: a. Areas with problems included Hondon road, the culvert near Rhosgoch and the hole in the road between Painscastle and Clyro, these to be forwarded to the Highways department.

REPORTS: a. Ombudsman report was discussed but no action taken.

CORRESPONDENCE: a. LDP consultation was now open and documents open for public inspection.

- b. Erwood station gallery were looking to establish a sculpture trail from the station to the river, no objections were raised.
- c. Painscastle Bus shelter, it had been proposed by some local residents to use the bus shelter as an information point, this was fully supported by the Council.
