## MINUTES of the MEETING of PAINSCASTLE COMMUNITY COUNCIL 17th March 2014

The Chairman, Cllr Mrs T Davies, opened the meeting and the following were present: Cllrs Mr PJ Lewis, Mr M Graham, Mr GD Jones, Mr DA Nicholls, Mr R Ball, Mrs J Smith and Powys C Cllr Mr C Davies.

Apologies were received from Cllrs Mr R Tyler

As there were no other objections to the minutes of the meeting held on 20th January 2014 these were signed by the Chairman.

PLANNING: a. Wernoog, Clyro, this application was for the erection of a wind turbine on land known as Clyro Hill. This application had been before the Planning Committee in March and had been refused.

- b. Tyllwyd, Painscastle, this application had been before the Planning Committee in February and had been refused.
- c. Rhosgoch Holiday Park, this application to extend the time limit for starting the development had been passed.
- d. Bwlchau Bettws, this application was outside the Council area and no comment was put forward.
- e. 3 Begwyns View, this application for a circular garden shed was discussed in the meeting. The Councillors felt that the structure was too large for the proposed site and also that a proper scale plan of the building was needed as the picture in the planning pack was misleading as to the actual size proposed.
- f. Lower Lundy, Painscastle, this application for the conversion of a barn and stable to residential use. This was fully supported.

FINANCE: a. Accounts (i) Current a/c £1519.36

HIGHWAYS: a. Mill Bridge, near Painscastle, this would be closed for 2 months from the 21<sup>st</sup> April for repair.

REPORTS: a. County Councillor, Chris Davies gave a short report again highlighting the cuts in Powys's Budget. Also that Erwood bridge would be opened on the 18<sup>th</sup> March.

CORRESPONDENCE: a. Friends of Health Care in Builth Wells and District had asked if a defibrillator could be kept in Painscastle Hall. This request would be passed to the Hall Committee.

b. National Marine Plan for Wales, this was discussed but no action taken.

APPEALS: a. Victim support, N.S.P.C.C. and Kidney Wales foundation were discussed but we were unable to support them financially.
